



## GFDRR Training on Damage, Loss and Needs Assessment Methodology

November 9-11, 2011, Feldafing

The Global Facility for Disaster Reduction and Recovery (GFDRR) and UNDG, in partnership with GIZ, are offering a Post Disaster Needs Assessment (PDNA) training with special focus on Damage and Loss Assessment.

### Objective:

The three days training aims at building basic understanding of the methodology for (i) assessing damages and losses, (ii) determining the needs for recovery and reconstruction, and (iii) ensuring the improved resilience of communities and countries following a major disaster. It will also familiarize participants with the role and relevance of partnerships between the WB/GFDRR in donor agencies in supporting disaster prone countries to reduce the risk of future disasters.

### Learning Outcomes:

- Familiarity of the role of Disaster Risk Management within the World Bank Group and awareness of the strategic objectives and business lines of the Global Facility for Disaster Reduction and Recovery (GFDRR)
- Proficiency in the commonly used terminology in PDNA.
- Basic understanding of methodology to assess damages, losses post disaster and to identify recovery and reconstruction needs.
- Technical skills to participate in PDNA missions.
- Awareness of the requirements and conditions for deployment.
