GFDRR's Vision A world where resilient societies manage and adapt to ever-changing disaster and climate risk, and where the human and economic impact of disasters is reduced.

The ACP-EU NDRR Program

- Targets all ACP countries through its 3 windows of intervention
- Projects are implemented by Government authorities, World Bank, UN agencies, Regional Organizations and NGOs



Prevention, Mitigation & Preparedness

to natural hazards in ACP countries







Regional Projects (Window 1)

to advance the national DRR agendas of ACP countries through regional/sub-regional cooperation.

Country-Level Projects (Window 2)

to drive DRR and climate change adaptation (CCA) policy development and implementation in ACP countries through need-based and demand-driven technical assistance, including provision of technical advisory capacity.

Post-Disaster & Capacity Building Activities (Window 3)

to improve the ability of ACP countries to respond to disasters efficiently and effectively by building ex-ante capacity to conduct post-disaster needs assessments, providing rapid technical assistance, and mainstreaming DRR in recovery planning.

ACP-EU NDRR - Expected results

- Improved resilience of ACP countries to the impact of natural disasters;
- Better preparedness of the population in disaster-prone areas;
- Reduction of the cost of response in the event of natural disasters.





ACP-EU NDRR - Type of Activities

A wide range of activities covering the full DRM spectrum


- DRM Mainstreaming;
- Community-based resilience;
- Land use planning;
- Risk financing;
- Preparedness and Early Warning Systems;
- Risk assessments, risk tools, data collection;
- DRM investments;
- Post-disaster assessments and recovery planning.



Financial leveraging of ACP-EU NDRR grants

Nearly **USD 2 billion** leveraged

37 projects resulted in additional investments in DRM and post-disaster operations.



Co-financing

- The grant is part of larger financing packages w/ IDA, GCF, GEF, PPCR, etc.
- · Co-financing avoids fragmentation of aid

Enabling

 GFDRR's financial or/and technical assistance has directly supported the design or/and implementation of a DRM investment.

Informing

 GFDRR's financial or/and technical assistance has been instrumental to mobilizing a larger investment (eg. knowledge products, risk assessments, post-disaster assessments).









