ECCAS: 11 MS: Angola, Equatorial Guinea, Burundi, Cameroun, Gabon, Congo, DRC, STP, Chad, Rwanda

Hazards:

- Climate Related: 70% (Floods, drought, storm, landslides)
- **Health related :** 20% (Ebola, cholera Epidemies)
- Geological related: 08% (Volcanos, land and rocks falls)
- Others: 02% (Locust & elephants invasions, social turmoil's,)





Lessons learned

Capacity and institutional building through training, awareness raising and advocacy are key to mainstream DRM and CCA

A lot of resources have been invested in DRM/CCA strengthening with less impact on resilience: Most of the programme or projects are designed without the beneficiaries and implemented without them.
